

NOTICE OF THE ENERGY REGULATOR PUBLIC HEARINGS

The National Energy Regulator ('the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act no. 60 of 2003) and the Petroleum Pipelines Levies Act, 2004 (Act No. 28 of 2004).

The Energy Regulator invites all members of the public and stakeholders to attend and/or to make oral representations at the public hearing to consider the development of the **Regulatory Reporting Manual (RRM) Volume 5 for the Electricity Supply Industry Non-Financial Information (NFI)**.
